AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY STATE STANDARDIZED TESTING OF STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a task force, which
- 2 consists of certified teachers from school districts of varying
- 3 demographics and grade levels, to study and develop recommendations
- 4 concerning the need for state standardized testing and its impact on
- 5 students.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a task force to evaluate all aspects and impacts of statemandated standardized testing on students, and provide recommendations on ways to improve implementation and methods of measuring student achievement.
