## AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF OUTDOOR WOOD-BURNING FURNACES ON NONATTAINMENT DAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 22a-174k of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective from
- 3 passage):
- 4 (c) (1) On and after June 6, 2014, no person shall burn any material in
- 5 any outdoor wood-burning furnace other than wood that is not
- 6 chemically treated.
- 7 (2) On and after the effective date of this section, no person shall
- 8 operate an outdoor wood-burning furnace on any day that the state is
- 9 not in attainment of the applicable federal limit for the presence of ozone
- in the state's atmosphere.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
