AN ACT CONCERNING THE RELEASE OF CERTAIN LIENS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 22a-5c of the general statutes is amended by adding
 subsection (c) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

(NEW) (c) Notwithstanding any provision of title 22a, any lien with
the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection as the claiming
party shall not continue in force for a period longer than sixty days after
such lien is discharged either by final payment or disposition, including,
but not limited to, the final disposition of any appeal taken with respect
to such lien.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 <i>from passage</i>	22a-5c(c)

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to release liens within a certain period of time when such lien has been satisfied.
