AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR BREAST RECONSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require health
- 2 insurance coverage, without any out-of-pocket expense, for nipple
- 3 reconstruction or nipple tattooing for all insureds who have undergone
- 4 a breast reconstruction surgery for a medically necessary purpose,
- 5 including prophylactic mastectomies.

Statement of Purpose:

To require health insurance coverage, without any out-of-pocket expense, for nipple reconstruction or nipple tattooing for all insureds who have undergone a breast reconstruction surgery for a medically necessary purpose, including prophylactic mastectomies.
