AN ACT REQUIRING A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF INSURANCE POOLING FOR NONPROFIT ENTITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Insurance Commissioner shall
- 2 study the feasibility of (1) allowing one or more nonprofit entities to
- 3 pool such nonprofit entities' liability insurance policies, including
- 4 general liability insurance and automobile liability insurance, and (2)
- 5 establishing a captive insurance company to insure the risk of such pool.
- 6 Not later than January 1, 2025, the Insurance Commissioner shall report,
- 7 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
- 8 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 9 cognizance of matters relating to insurance on the findings of such
- 10 study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 from passage New section

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Statement of Purpose:

To require that the Insurance Commissioner conduct a feasibility study of general liability and automobile liability insurance pooling for nonprofit entities.
