AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A CAPTIVE INSURANCE COMPANY TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO FARMERS IMPACTED BY THE EFFECTS OF SEVERE WEATHER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Insurance Commissioner, in 2 consultation with the Commissioner of Agriculture, shall conduct a 3 feasibility study for establishing a captive insurance company to 4 provide financial assistance to farmers in this state who are impacted by 5 the effects of severe weather.
- 6 (b) Not later than January 1, 2025, the Insurance Commissioner shall 7 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general 8 statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly 9 having cognizance of matters relating to insurance on any 10 recommendations concerning the establishment of a captive insurance 11 company to provide financial assistance to farmers in this state who are 12 impacted by the effects of severe weather.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require that the Insurance Commissioner, in consultation with the Commissioner of Agriculture, conduct a feasibility study for establishing a captive insurance company to provide financial assistance to farmers in the state impacted by the effects of severe weather.
