AN ACT CONCERNING WORKERS' RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Labor Commissioner shall 2 conduct a study of the rights of employees in this state. Not later than 3 January 1, 2025, the commissioner shall report the results of the study, 4 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, 5 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having 6 cognizance of matters relating to labor. Such report may include the 7 commissioner's recommendations for legislation regarding the rights of 8 employees in the state.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following

To require the Labor Commissioner to study workers' rights in the state.
