AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VIRTUAL SCHOOL IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 163 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 State Board of Education to establish a state-wide virtual school that
- 3 offers instruction to students in grades kindergarten to twelve,
- 4 inclusive, who are unable to attend school in person due to a medical
- 5 issue or condition or vaccination status.

Statement of Purpose:

To offer an alternative education opportunity for certain students who are unable to attend school in person.
