AN ACT INCREASING THE CIVICS CREDIT REQUIREMENT FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-221a of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the civics and American government credit requirement from a one-half
- 3 credit course to a one credit course for purposes of the high school
- 4 graduation requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase citizenship and civic literacy by requiring students to earn one full credit of civics instruction as part of high school graduation requirements in Connecticut.
