AN ACT CONCERNING LEAVE OF LEVEL TWO OR NONESSENTIAL STATE EMPLOYEES ASSISTING IN A CIVIL PREPAREDNESS EMERGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 5-249 of the 2020 supplement to the general statutes
- 2 is amended by adding subsection (f) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2020*):
- 3 (NEW) (f) (1) For the purposes of this subsection, (A) "civil
- 4 preparedness emergency" and "local civil preparedness emergency"
- 5 have the same meanings as provided in section 28-1, and (B) "level 2 or
- 6 nonessential state employee" means an employee whose employing
- 7 state agency has not deemed essential to addressing the needs of state
- 8 residents in the face of events that can have an adverse effect on health
- 9 and safety or normal business operations.
- 10 (2) Any state employee who is designated as a level two or
- 11 nonessential state employee and is a volunteer of a local organization
- 12 for civil preparedness, established pursuant to section 28-7, may, with
- 13 the authorization of such employee's supervisor, be granted a leave not
- 14 to exceed fifteen working days in each year to assist in a civil

- preparedness emergency or local civil preparedness emergency, upon
- 16 the request of the local chief executive authority, the Governor or the
- 17 Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection and in
- 18 accordance with the provisions of section 28-7, without loss of pay,
- 19 vacation time, sick leave or earned overtime accumulation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following

Statement of Purpose:

To permit level two or nonessential state employees who volunteer with a local organization for civil preparedness to assist in a civil preparedness emergency or local civil preparedness emergency without loss of pay, vacation time, sick leave or earned overtime accumulation.
