AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FREEZE OR REDUCTION ON PROPERTY TAXES FOR QUALIFIED DISABLED VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended to provide that a
- 2 municipality may allow any disabled veteran owner of real property
- 3 who meets certain qualifications to pay the tax levied on such property
- 4 for the first year such veteran's claim for tax relief is filed and
- 5 approved and (1) to continue to pay the amount of such tax or such
- 6 lesser amount as may be levied in any year during each subsequent
- 7 year that such disabled veteran meets such qualifications, or (2) to pay
- 8 a lesser amount as may be levied in any year during any subsequent
- 9 year that such disabled veteran meets such qualifications.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit municipalities to provide a freeze or reduction on property taxes for disabled veterans that meet certain qualifications.
