AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE NEEDS OF SENIOR CITIZENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The executive director of the
- 2 Commission on Women, Children, Seniors, Equity and Opportunity, in
- 3 consultation with the Commissioner of Aging and Disability Services,
- 4 shall study the needs of senior citizens in the state in order to ensure the
- 5 adequate allocation of resources.
- 6 (b) The study shall include, but need not be limited to, the needs of
- 7 senior citizens for (1) long-term care, (2) transportation, (3) housing
- 8 assistance, (4) nutritional assistance, and (5) opportunities for
- 9 socialization.
- 10 (c) On or before January 1, 2025, the executive director shall report
- 11 the results of the study, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
- 4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General
- 13 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to aging.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
