## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE OMBUDSMAN'S OFFICE FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTHCARE COVERAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17a of the general statutes be amended to establish the
- 2 Ombudsman's Office for Behavioral Healthcare, modeled on the Office
- 3 of the Healthcare Advocate, to expand behavioral health care coverage
- 4 by (1) recommending to state Medicaid and private insurance regulators
- 5 structural and accountability guidelines to ensure a fair and equitable
- 6 private and public insurance reimbursement system for small and
- 7 group behavioral health care providers, (2) investigating and resolving
- 8 reimbursement-related barriers and other obstacles that impede
- 9 provision of care by such providers, and (3) making public policy
- 10 recommendations to expand behavioral health care opportunities for all
- 11 persons regardless of type of insurance coverage.

## Statement of Purpose:

To expand access to behavioral health care by establishing a state ombudsman's office to reduce private and public insurance reimbursement barriers for small and group health care providers.
