**AN ACT REQUIRING ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION COMPANIES TO PROVIDE GENERATION INFORMATION TO CUSTOMERS WITH RESIDENTIAL PHOTOVOLTAIC SOLAR SYSTEMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2022*) Each electric distribution  
2 company shall provide the following information on the electric bills of  
3 residential customers, as defined in subsection (b) of section 16-244z of  
4 the general statutes, who generate electricity through on-premises  
5 photovoltaic solar systems: (1) The total generation of such photovoltaic  
6 solar systems in kilowatts per monthly billing period; and (2) the  
7 amount of excess power sold to the company in kilowatts and dollars  
8 per monthly billing period.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>July 1, 2022</i>	New section
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***Statement of Purpose:***

To require electric distribution companies to provide on-bill information to customers with residential solar detailing the generation from the solar systems and the amount of excess power sold to the electric distribution company in kilowatts and dollars.
