## AN ACT CONCERNING THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION YOUTH RISK BEHAVIOR SURVEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2020) (a) For the school year
- 2 commencing July 1, 2020, and biennially thereafter, the Department of
- 3 Public Health shall administer the Connecticut School Health Survey to
- 4 high school students in the state. The survey shall be based on the Youth
- 5 Risk Behavior Survey developed by the National Centers for Disease
- 6 Control and Prevention. The department shall randomly select the high
- 7 schools that shall participate in the survey in any school year. The
- 8 department shall provide guidance to the local or regional board of
- 9 education for each high school selected to participate in the survey
- 10 relating to (1) best practices for administering the survey, (2) the
- 11 timeframe for completion of the survey, and (3) the process by which
- the results of such survey are to be submitted to the department.
- 13 (b) The department, in consultation with the Department of Mental
- 14 Health and Addiction Services, the Office of Early Childhood, the
- 15 Department of Children and Families, the Department of Education and

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- 16 any other agency or public interest group the department deems
- 17 necessary, may develop survey questions that are relevant to the health
- 18 concerns of high school students in the state that shall be included as
- 19 part of the Connecticut School Health Survey.
- Sec. 2. (Effective July 1, 2020) Not later than October 1, 2020, the Child
- Advocate, in consultation with the Department of Public Health, shall
- 22 develop questions designed to assess the risk of youths being victims of
- 23 sexual assault or misconduct by an adult. Such questions shall be
- 24 included as part of the Connecticut School Health Survey administered
- 25 pursuant to section 1 of this act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

## Statement of Purpose:

To require (1) the Department of Public Health to administer the national Youth Risk Behavior Survey, (2) high schools to participate in the survey, if selected, and (3) the Child Advocate to develop questions assessing the risk to youths of being victims of sexual assault or misconduct by an adult.
