Substitute Bill No. 5334



AN ACT REQUIRING THE MAJORITY LEADERS' ROUNDTABLE GROUP ON AFFORDABLE HOUSING TO STUDY RESIDENTIAL MOBILITY COUNSELING PROGRAMS IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The majority leaders' roundtable
2 group on affordable housing, established pursuant to section 2-139 of
3 the general statutes, shall conduct a study concerning the effectiveness
4 of residential mobility counseling programs, including the residence
5 mobility counseling program established by the Commissioner of
6 Housing pursuant to section 8-348 of the general statutes or any similar
7 mobility counseling program provided by any not-for-profit housing
8 advocacy organization in the state. Not later than January 1, 2025, the
9 roundtable group shall submit a report, in accordance with the
10 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, on its findings and
11 any recommendations to the joint standing committee of the General
12 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
