AN ACT CONCERNING MEMBERSHIP OF THE LOW-INCOME ENERGY ADVISORY BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 16a-41b of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*,
- 3 2022):
- 4 (a) There shall be a Low-Income Energy Advisory Board which shall
- 5 consist of the following members or their designees: (1) A representative
- 6 of each electric and gas public service company designated by each such
- 7 company; (2) the chairperson of the Public Utilities Regulatory
- 8 Authority; (3) the Consumer Counsel; (4) the executive director of
- 9 Operation Fuel; (5) the executive director of Infoline; (6) the director of
- 10 the Connecticut Local Administrators of Social Services; (7) the
- 11 executive director of Legal Assistance Resource Center of Connecticut;
- 12 (8) the Connecticut [president] state director of AARP; (9) a designee of
- 13 the Norwich Public Utility; (10) a designee of the Independent
- 14 Connecticut Petroleum Association; (11) two representatives of
- 15 <u>municipal or regional owned water utilities, designated by the</u>
- 16 Connecticut Water Works Association; (12) the executive director of the
- 17 Connecticut Fair Housing Center; (13) the executive director of the
- 18 Center for Children's Advocacy; (14) the executive director of the
- 19 <u>Connecticut Green Building Council;</u> and [a representative] (15) two
- 20 <u>representatives</u> of the community action agencies administering energy

- 21 assistance programs under contract with the Department of Social
- 22 Services, designated by the Connecticut Association for Community
- 23 Action. The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management and the
- 24 Commissioners of Social Services and Energy and Environmental
- 25 Protection, or their designees, shall serve as nonvoting members of the
- 26 board.
