AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' SELECTION OF AN EXCLUSIVE BARGAINING UNIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 68 of the general statutes be amended to: (1) Allow 2 public employees to vote, at least every four years, to (A) redesignate 3 their current employee organization as their exclusive bargaining agent, 4 (B) select a different employee organization to represent them, (C) 5 choose to have no employee organization represent them, and (D) 6 organize a new employee organization; (2) require that, if no such 7 election is conducted in such a four-year period or in the manner 8 required, the employee organization shall be undesignated by the State 9 Board of Labor Relations; (3) require that an employee organization 10 receive votes from a majority of all employees who will be represented, 11 regardless of membership, in order to be designated as an exclusive 12 representative; (4) require that voting be by secret ballot and that such 13 voting may be conducted by phone, Internet or other means; (5) require 14 that the cost of such election be the responsibility of the employee 15 organization; and (6) require that, in the event that an employee 16 organization is no longer designated as the exclusive representative of

17 a collective bargaining unit, a similar or affiliated employee

18 organization shall not reorganize the bargaining unit within one year of

19 the election.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect public employees' right to elect a union of their choice to represent their interests.
