## AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN FINANCIALLY DISTRESSED MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 7 of the general statutes be amended to require (1) the 2 Auditors of Public Accounts to audit financially distressed
- 3 municipalities that have been referred to the Municipal Accountability
- 4 Review Board, and (2) legislative review of any debt service contracts
- 5 between such municipalities and the Office of Policy and Management.

## Statement of Purpose:

To require the Auditors of Public Accounts to audit certain financially distressed municipalities and require legislative review of debt service contracts between such municipalities and the Office of Policy and Management.
