## AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES TO ESTABLISH TRAFFIC AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2023) Any municipality having a
- 2 population of not less than fifty thousand may, by vote of its legislative
- 3 body, establish a traffic authority and appoint one or more members to
- 4 serve on such traffic authority. The qualifications, terms of office and
- 5 compensation, if any, of any such members shall be prescribed by such
- 6 legislative body. A traffic authority established pursuant to this section
- 7 shall replace any existing traffic authority in such municipality and have
- 8 the same powers and duties as a traffic authority described in
- 9 subparagraphs (A) to (C), inclusive, of subdivision (7) of section 14-297
- of the general statutes, as amended by this act.
- 11 Sec. 2. Subdivision (7) of section 14-297 of the general statutes is
- repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*,
- 13 2023):
- 14 (7) "Traffic authority" means (A) the board of police commissioners

15 of any city, town or borough, [or] (B) the city or town manager, [the] 16 chief of police, [the] superintendent of police or any legally elected or 17 appointed official or board [, or any official] having similar powers and duties, of any city, town or borough that has no board of police 18 19 commissioners but has a regularly appointed police force, [or] (C) the 20 board of selectmen of any town in which there is no city or borough with 21 a regularly appointed police force, or (D) a traffic authority established 22 pursuant to section 1 of this act, except that, with respect to state 23 highways and bridges, "traffic authority" means the Office of the State 24 Traffic Administration, provided nothing contained in this section shall 25 be construed to limit or detract from the jurisdiction or authority of the 26 Office of the State Traffic Administration to adopt regulations 27 establishing a uniform system of traffic control signals, devices, signs 28 and markings as provided in section 14-298, and the requirement that 29 no installation of any traffic control signal light shall be made by any 30 city, town or borough until the installation has been approved by the 31 Office of the State Traffic Administration as provided in section 14-299;
