AN ACT CONCERNING EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force 2 to study the feasibility of establishing a pathways in technology early 3 college high school program in school districts designated as alliance 4 districts pursuant to section 10-262u of the general statutes, which 5 program would enroll students from towns surrounding such school 6 districts. Such study shall include, but need not be limited to, (1) 7 identification of alliance districts where such programs may be placed, 8 (2) identification of companies or business entities with whom an 9 alliance district may partner to develop such program, and (3) 10 identification of sources of funding to establish such programs.

11 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

12 (1) Two appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

13 (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;

14	(3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of

16	(4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;		
17	(5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of

19	(6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;		
20	(7) The Commissioner of Education, or the commissioner's designee;

22	(8) The president of the Connecticut State Colleges and Universities,		
23	or the president's designee.		
24	(c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),		
25	(2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member		
26	of the General Assembly.

27	(d) All initial appointments to the task force shall be made not later		
28	than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall		
29	be filled by the appointing authority.		
30	(e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president pro		
31	tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task force from		
32	among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons shall schedule		
33	the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not later than sixty		
34	days after the effective date of this section.		
35	(f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the		
36	General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education		
37	shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.		
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38	(g) Not later than January 1, 2021, the task force shall submit a report		
38 39	(g) Not later than January 1, 2021, the task force shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of		
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- 42 general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date that it
- 43 submits such report or January 1, 2021, whichever is later.
