AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND PUBLIC PROTECTION TO PROVIDE INFORMATION AND STATISTICS ON CRIMES AND FATALITIES INVOLVING FIREARMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of 2 Emergency Services and Public Protection to make available more 3 detailed information and statistics regarding crimes and fatalities 4 involving firearms, including, but not limited to, crimes committed by 5 individuals with prior convictions who were prohibited from 6 possessing the firearm and crimes committed with illegally possessed 7 or unregistered firearms.

Statement of Purpose:

To assist policymakers in evaluating and crafting firearms legislation by ensuring access to complete and meaningful statistics.
