AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEMS BY CERTAIN COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 14 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 commercial motor vehicles that are designed or used to transport
- 3 passengers or property and have a gross vehicle weight rating of ten
- 4 thousand pounds or more to be equipped with a global positioning
- 5 system capable of informing the driver of such vehicle of clearance
- 6 restrictions, load limits, one-way streets and traffic restrictions.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase public safety by requiring certain commercial motor vehicles to be equipped with global positioning systems capable of providing drivers with adequate warnings of clearance, load and traffic restrictions.
