

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Comptroller shall conduct a study of health insurance coverage for retired police officers in this state. Such study shall include, but need not be limited to, an assessment of any gaps in, or lack of, health insurance coverage, or diminished health insurance coverage for police officers in this state who are no longer employed as police officers due to normal retirement, or early retirement as a result of any illness or injury. Not later than January 1, 2025, the Comptroller shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance on the findings of such study. For purposes of this section, "police officer" has the same meaning as provided in section 7294a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
