AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC EMPLOYEE VOTING RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to protect public employee
- 2 voting rights by allowing such employees to vote to recertify their
- 3 union, vote for a different union to represent them, vote for no union or
- 4 vote to organize a new union at least once every four years. If no election
- 5 is conducted in the time and manner required, the union shall be
- 6 decertified. In order to be certified, a union shall receive votes from a
- 7 majority of all employees who will be represented, regardless of union
- 8 membership. Voting shall be by secret ballot and such voting may be
- 9 conducted by phone, Internet or other means. The costs of the election
- shall be borne by the union. In the event that a union is no longer
- 11 certified, a similar or affiliated union may not reorganize the bargaining
- 12 unit within one year of the election.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect public employees' rights to elect a union of their choice to represent their interests.
