***AN ACT REQUIRING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A RECIPROCAL
FOOD TRUCK VENDOR PERMIT OR LICENSE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-36i of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Public Health to implement the process by which a food
- 3 truck vendor may operate in municipalities other than the municipality
- 4 from which it obtained a permit or license to operate as an itinerant food
- 5 vending establishment.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow for more efficiency for food truck vendors by reducing paperwork and saving costs associated with obtaining a permit or license from every municipality in which a food truck vendor seeks to operate.
