AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ELECTRONIC NICOTINE DELIVERY SYSTEMS AND VAPOR PRODUCTS THAT ARE FLAVORED OR HAVE A NICOTINE CONTENT GREATER THAN THIRTY-FIVE MILLIGRAMS PER MILLILITER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the sale of any
- 2 electronic nicotine delivery system or vapor product that is flavored or
- 3 has a nicotine content greater than thirty-five milligrams per milliliter.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve public health and lower health care costs.
