AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEE VACATION TIME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2024*) The Commissioner of Administrative
- 2 Services shall study the policies adopted by state employers regarding
- 3 the transfer of a state employee's unused vacation time when such
- 4 employee transfers to another position in state service. Such study shall
- 5 include, but need not be limited to, a review of the current limitations
- 6 on transferring unused paid sick days. Not later than January 1, 2025,
- 7 the commissioner shall submit such study to the joint standing
- 8 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 9 relating to labor and public employees, in accordance with the
- 10 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 July 1, 2024 New section

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Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Administrative Services to study the policies on the transfer of state employees' unused vacation time.
