AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION OF DUAL INSTRUCTION AS PART OF REMOTE LEARNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That section 10-4w of the general statutes be amended to revise the prohibition on the provision of dual instruction as part of remote learning to permit students who are receiving special education and related services to receive such dual instruction, provided such remote learning is included in the individualized education program for such students.

Statement of Purpose:

To clarify the prohibition on dual instruction as part of remote learning for students receiving special education.
