***AN ACT PROHIBITING EMPLOYERS AND PUBLIC OFFICIALS FROM
REQUIRING PROOF OF COVID-19 VACCINATION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit (1) employers from
- 2 requiring proof of the COVID-19 vaccination from employees,
- 3 prospective employees, customers or vendors, (2) employers from
- 4 inquiring into the COVID-19 vaccination records of employees,
- 5 prospective employees, customers or vendors, and (3) public officials
- 6 from requiring proof of COVID-19 vaccination for use of state or
- 7 municipal lands, parks or buildings.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit employers and public officials from requiring proof of COVID-19 vaccination.
