## AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF ATLANTIC STANDARD TIME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1-6 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2020*):
- 3 [The] (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the
- 4 standard of time for the seventy-fifth meridian west of Greenwich shall
- 5 be the standard of time for this state, except that the standard of time of
- 6 this state shall be one hour in advance of such established time from two
- 7 o'clock ante meridian on the second Sunday in March until two o'clock
- 8 ante meridian on the first Sunday in November.
- 9 (b) Upon the enactment of legislation in the states of Massachusetts,
- 10 Rhode Island and New York adopting Atlantic standard time, the
- 11 Governor of this state shall forthwith apply to the United States
- 12 Secretary of Transportation to change the standard of time for this state
- 13 to Atlantic standard time. If such application is approved by the
- secretary, the standard of time for this state shall be Atlantic standard
