## Substitute Bill No. 5410

## AN ACT EXEMPTING INFORMATION CONCERNING CERTAIN VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 1-210 of the 2024 supplement to
- 2 the general statutes is amended by adding subdivisions (29) and (30) as
- 3 follows (*Effective October 1, 2024*):
- 4 (NEW) (29) Records of a public agency related to an investigation of
- 5 alleged sexual harassment in violation of subdivision (8) of subsection
- 6 (b) of section 46a-60 or an alleged discriminatory practice, as defined in
- 7 section 46a-51, concerning an employee of the public agency, including
- 8 the name of any person providing information concerning such alleged
- 9 violation or discriminatory practice;
- 10 (NEW) (30) Records contained within the registry of residents of the
- state with cognitive challenges created by the Division of State Police
- 12 within the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection for
- purposes of assisting in the recovery of missing or wandering persons.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
