AN ACT CONCERNING FINANCIAL INCENTIVES AND DISINCENTIVES FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS RELATED TO HIGH SCHOOL START TIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-262h of the general statutes be amended to revise the
- 2 formula used to calculate a town's equalization aid grant to increase a
- 3 town's grant by five per cent if such town establishes a high school start
- 4 time that is 8:30 a.m. or later, and to decrease a town's grant by five per
- 5 cent if such town establishes a high school start time that is earlier than
- 6 8:30 a.m.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage boards of education to establish high school start times that are based on research findings that demonstrates that high school students perform better when they get more sleep and rest.
