AN ACT CONCERNING THE MODIFICATION OR REVOCATION OF CONSENT ORDERS BY THE COMMISSIONER OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the Commissioner
- 2 of Energy and Environmental Protection, or his or her designee, from
- 3 modifying or revoking a consent order without the approval of the other
- 4 parties to such consent order.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that any consent order entered into by a party and the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection, or the commissioner's designee, is not modified or revoked without the consent of the parties affected by the order.
