AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF DOGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require businesses concerned with the care of dogs, including, but not limited to, veterinary clinics and hospitals, animal feed stores, pet stores, pet grooming shops and independent pet groomers and dog training and boarding facilities, develop and distribute a document to customers of such businesses containing a description of and reference to section 22-338 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To facilitate the annual licensing of dogs by requiring the provision of information concerning the law relating to dog licensing by businesses concerned with the care of dogs.
