## AN ACT CONCERNING ADDITIONAL METHODS AND RESOURCES TO DETER JUVENILE AUTO THEFT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That: (1) Subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 46b-127 of the 2 general statutes be amended to require the automatic transfer to the 3 regular criminal docket of the Superior Court in the case of a child 4 charged with a violation of section 53a-123 or 53a-124 of the general 5 statutes if the property includes a motor vehicle, or criminal attempt of the same; (2) subdivision (3) of subsection (a) of section 46b-127 of the 6 7 general statutes be amended to strike the reference to section 53a-122 of 8 the general statutes; (3) subsection (c) of section 46b-133 of the general 9 statutes be amended to expand the circumstances in which a court can 10 order a juvenile be detained prior to a court hearing if the juvenile is 11 arrested for larceny involving a motor vehicle, and also permit the court 12 to order, in lieu of detention, global positioning system monitoring of a 13 juvenile awaiting a court hearing; (4) subdivision (10) of section 46b-120 14 of the general statutes be amended to expand the definition of "serious

- 15 juvenile repeat offender" to include a child who has previously been
- 16 adjudicated delinquent for misdemeanor larceny offenses involving
- motor vehicles; and (5) chapter 815 of the general statutes be amended
- 18 to require an investigation by the Department of Children and Families
- 19 if a juvenile is charged with larceny involving a motor vehicle, and to
- 20 provide necessary family support services and educational
- 21 opportunities for such juvenile, as well.

## Statement of Purpose:

To offer additional pretrial educational and diversionary resources for juveniles in the criminal justice system while promoting public safety and reducing motor vehicle thefts by persistent juvenile offenders.
