AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE CIVIL LAWS IN THIS STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) There is established a working group 2 to study the civil laws of this state. Such study shall include, but not be 3 limited to, a review of provisions set forth in various titles of the general 4 statutes, including, but not limited to, titles 51 and 52 of the general 5 statutes for the purpose of recommending needed changes to such 6 provisions of the general statutes. The working group shall consist of the following members, who have familiarity with and expertise in the 8 interpretation of the state's civil laws: (1) One appointed by the speaker 9 of the House of Representatives; (2) one appointed by the president pro 10 tempore of the Senate; (3) one appointed by the majority leader of the 11 House of Representatives; (4) one appointed by the majority leader of 12 the Senate; (5) one appointed by the minority leader of the House of 13 Representatives; and (6) one appointed by the minority leader of the 14 Senate. Not later than January 1, 2025, the working group shall submit 15 a report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing 16 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters

- 17 relating to the judiciary, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
- 4a of the general statutes. The working group shall terminate on the date
- 19 that it submits such report or January 1, 2025, whichever is later.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
