

## AN ACT PROHIBITING THE DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN CONTACT INFORMATION UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2022) Any list of contact information or portion of such list created or modified by a member of the General Assembly or such member's staff for purposes related to the member's public office, shall be confidential and shall not be subject to disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act. Any such list may be disclosed to a public agency of the state for a governmental purpose, provided (1) any such disclosure for governmental purposes shall not make such list a public record for purposes of the Freedom of Information Act, and (2) such list may not be disclosed or used for purposes of a political campaign, primary, referendum or election. For purposes of this section, "contact information" means an individual's electronic mail address and "Freedom of Information Act" and "public agency" have the same meanings as provided in section 1-200 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To exempt certain contact information created by a member of the General Assembly for official purposes from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act and to prohibit its use for campaign purposes.
