AN ACT ALLOWING A PERSONAL INCOME TAX DEDUCTION FOR STIPENDS PAID TO VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS, FIRE POLICE OFFICERS AND VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE MEMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended to exempt from the
- 2 personal income tax any stipend paid by a municipality, volunteer fire
- 3 department or volunteer ambulance association to a volunteer
- 4 firefighter, fire police officer or volunteer ambulance member.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a personal income tax deduction for a stipend made by a municipality, volunteer fire department or volunteer ambulance association to a volunteer firefighter, fire police officer or volunteer ambulance member.

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
