AN ACT PROHIBITING THE MISREPRESENTATION OF A DOG AS A SERVICE ANIMAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 46a of the general statutes be amended to provide that no 2 individual may knowingly represent, whether expressly or impliedly, 3 that a dog is a service animal or being trained as a service animal for 4 an individual with a disability, as such animal and individual are 5 defined in 28 CFR 35.104, as amended from time to time, for the 6 purpose of obtaining any rights or privileges afforded to such an 7 individual, unless such dog is a service animal or is being trained to be 8 a service animal.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit misrepresentation of a pet dog as a service animal in order to receive benefits reserved for persons with disabilities.
