## AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF STATE REVENUE COLLECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Commissioner of Revenue
- 2 Services shall study the Department of Revenue Services' collections
- 3 processes to identify legislative and programmatic changes that may be
- 4 made to improve efficiency and reduce administrative costs of such
- 5 collections. Not later than January 1, 2025, the commissioner shall
- 6 submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
- 7 general statutes, on the commissioner's findings and recommendations
- 8 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 9 cognizance of matters relating to finance, revenue and bonding.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
