**AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE COURT TO ENTER
ORDERS OF SUPPORT FOR AN ADULT CHILD WHO IS TWENTY-
ONE OR OLDER AND HAS AN INTELLECTUAL, MENTAL OR
PHYSICAL DISABILITY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46b-84 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the court may, based upon a party's financial circumstances, make
- 3 appropriate orders of support of an adult child with an intellectual,
- 4 mental or physical disability.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the court to order financial support for an adult child who
has an intellectual, mental or physical disability when one parent
proportionately has greater financial ability to support the adult child.
