AN ACT CONCERNING ORGANIZATIONAL REVISIONS TO ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION PROCEDURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 9-19j of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective from
- 3 passage):

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- 4 (c) (1) The registrars of voters shall designate a location for the
 - completion and processing of election day registration applications on
- 6 election day, provided (A) the registrars of voters shall have access to
- 7 the state-wide centralized voter registration system from such location,
- 8 and (B) such location shall be certified in writing to the Secretary of the
- 9 State not later than thirty-one days before such election day. The written
- 10 <u>certification required pursuant to subparagraph (B) of this subdivision</u>
- 11 shall (i) include the name, street address and relevant contact
- 12 <u>information associated with such location, (ii) list the name and address</u>
- of each election official appointed to serve at such location, if any, and
- 14 (iii) provide a description of the design of such location and a plan for

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- 15 <u>effective completion and processing of such applications. Upon review</u>
- of such written certification, the Secretary may require the registrars of
- 17 <u>voters to appoint one or more additional election officials or to alter such</u>
- 18 <u>design or plan.</u>
- 19 (2) The registrars of voters may apply to the Secretary of the State, in
- 20 <u>a form and manner prescribed by the Secretary, to designate any</u>
- 21 additional location for the completion and processing of election day
- 22 registration applications on election day, provided the registrars of
- 23 voters shall so apply not later than ninety days before such election day.
- 24 Upon approval of any such application by the Secretary, the registrars
- 25 of voters may so designate any such additional location. The provisions
- 26 of subdivision (1) of this subsection shall apply to any such additional
- 27 <u>location designated pursuant to this subdivision.</u>
- 28 [(2)] (3) The registrars of voters may [appoint one or more election
- 29 officials to serve at such location and may delegate to such election
- 30 officials] delegate to each election official appointed pursuant to
- 31 <u>subdivision (1) of this subsection, if any,</u> any of the responsibilities
- 32 assigned to the registrars of voters. The registrars of voters shall
- 33 supervise <u>each</u> such election [officials] <u>official</u> and train <u>each</u> such
- 34 election [officials] official to be an election day registration election
- 35 [officials] <u>official</u>.
- 36 Sec. 2. Subsection (j) of section 9-19j of the general statutes is repealed
- 37 and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 38 (j) No person shall solicit in behalf of or in opposition to the candidacy
- of another or himself or herself or in behalf of or in opposition to any
- 40 question being submitted at the election, or loiter or peddle or offer any
- 41 advertising matter, ballot or circular to another person within a radius
- 42 of seventy-five feet of any outside entrance in use as an entry to [the
- 43 registrars' of voters designated location] any location designated by the
- 44 <u>registrars of voters</u> for election day registration balloting or in any
- 45 corridor, passageway or other approach leading from any such outside
- 46 entrance to [such registrars' of voters designated] any such location or

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in any room opening upon any such corridor, passageway or approach.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:		
Section 1	from passage	9-19j(c)
Sec. 2	from passage	9-19j(j)

Statement of Purpose:

To permit towns to provide additional locations for election day registration and require that registrars of voters advise the Secretary of the State of expected staffing levels at election day registration locations.
