AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) increase the
- 2 reimbursement rates for home-based and center-based providers of
- 3 early childhood education, (2) address wages for teachers and providers
- 4 of early childhood education, and (3) address staff recruitment and
- 5 retention issues in early childhood education.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase reimbursement rates, address wages, and staff recruitment and retention in early childhood education with the goal of expanding access to affordable early childhood education.
