AN ACT CONCERNING CONTESTED ELECTIONS FOR STATE LEGISLATIVE OFFICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that (1) an 2 aggrieved party may bring a complaint to the Superior Court regarding 3 an election for a member of the General Assembly, unless the applicable 4 chamber of thereof has adopted a rule requiring submission of such a 5 complaint to a committee on contested elections, (2) in the case where 6 such a committee has received such a complaint and has made 7 recommendations thereon to the applicable chamber of the General 8 Assembly, but such chamber fails to vote upon such recommendations 9 within a specified period of time, jurisdiction over such complaint shall 10 vest in the Superior Court, and (3) in the case where jurisdiction over 11 such a complaint has so vested in the Superior Court, the court shall 12 proceed expeditiously on such complaint and provide relief without 13 undue delay.

Statement of Purpose:

To grant jurisdiction over contested elections for state legislative offices to the Superior Court under certain circumstances where the General Assembly has not taken action.
