AN ACT CONCERNING THE FINGERPRINT DATA OF TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the 2 Department of Education to serve as the central repository for teacher 3 fingerprint data and to share such data with local or regional boards of
- 4 education upon request when a teacher applies for employment within
- 5 the school district governed by such board.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Education to serve as the central repository of teacher fingerprint data and to share such data with local or regional boards of education for the purpose of reducing the number of times teachers are required to have fingerprints taken.
