***AN ACT CONCERNING LIVING ORGAN DONOR INSURANCE
DISCRIMINATION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to provide that: (1)
2 No insurer delivering, issuing for delivery, renewing, amending or
3 continuing a life insurance policy, long-term care insurance policy or a
4 policy providing disability income protection coverage in this state on
5 or after January 1, 2022, shall make any distinction or discriminate
6 against an individual in delivering, issuing for delivery, renewing,
7 amending, continuing, offering, withholding or cancelling such policy,
8 or in the terms of such policy, solely because such individual is a living
9 organ donor; and (2) prohibited discrimination against a living organ
10 donor constitutes a violation of the Connecticut Unfair Insurance
11 Practices Act.

Statement of Purpose:

To: (1) Prohibit certain insurers from discriminating against an individual solely because the individual is a living organ donor; and (2)

provide that prohibited discrimination against a living organ donor constitutes a violation of the Connecticut Unfair Insurance Practices Act.
