AN ACT CONCERNING ITINERANT FOOD VENDING ESTABLISHMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (e) of section 19a-36i of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require the Department of Public Health and each director
- 3 of health to implement, not later than December 31, 2021, the process
- 4 that allows for the reciprocal licensing of an itinerant food vending
- 5 establishment that has obtained a valid permit or license and seeks to
- 6 operate as an itinerant food vending establishment in another town, city
- 7 or borough.

To support our small businesses with the implementation of reciprocal local licensing for food trucks.
