AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF XERISCAPING AND OTHER LOW-IMPACT LANDSCAPING BY CERTAIN HOMEOWNERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to enable homeowners to opt
- 2 for low-impact landscaping solutions such as rain and pollinator
- 3 gardens and xeriscaping without being subject to homeowners'
- 4 association or other local regulations that may impact the effectiveness
- 5 of such landscaping.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage low-impact landscaping that benefits the environment while protecting homeowners from rules or regulations that may affect the use and effectiveness of such practices.
