**AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF ORGANIC SYSTEMS FOR
PESTICIDE MANAGEMENT ON STATE AND MUNICIPAL LANDS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the use of organic
- 2 systems for pesticide management on state and municipal lands,
- 3 including a prohibition on the use of neonicotinoids on lawns,
- 4 ornamental landscapes and agricultural seeds unless an emergency
- 5 condition exists.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect human health as well as pollinators and birds from poisoning from certain pesticides.
